HADRIAN'S WALL, THE LOSS OF THE NINTH LEGION AND CONFLICT IN THE HADRIANIC PERIOD

The evidence for conflict in Britain under Hadrian – its extent, location and effects (and of course its reality) – will be the central topic of the conference. Recent studies have explored the possibility that the loss of the Ninth Legion occurred during a war in Britain when the Wall was being built rather than several decades later, long after the legion had moved from Britain. There are also discoveries in London that have been taken by some modern commentators to suggest that the city was destroyed in a Hadrianic war. Broader discussion of warfare under Hadrian and in the following years will include presentations on the Jewish war late in his reign and the siege works at Burnswark, together with a paper on conflict archaeology.
